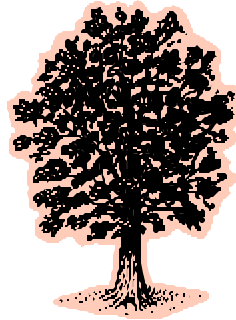


Camp Whittier Outdoor Education Program
